- 1 On May 24, 2017 CRISIL had assigned its 'CRISIL AA+/Stable' rating to the Rs 4,500 Million non-convertible debentures of Apollo Tyres Ltd (Apollo) and reaffirmed its ratings on the long-term bank facilities & debt programmes at 'CRISIL AA+/Stable' and short-term bank facilities & commercial paper at 'CRISIL A1+'.
- 2 The listed Non-Convertible Debentures (NCDs) issued by the Company is aggregating to Rs. 11,750 Million as on September 30, 2017, out of which NCDs aggregating to Rs. 10,750 Million are secured by a pari passu first charge by way of hypothecation on movable fixed assets of the Company, both present & future (except stocks & book debts), while the balance NCDs aggregating to Rs. 1,000 Million are secured by a pari passu first charge by way of mortgage on certain immovable fixed assets and by way of hypothecation on movable fixed assets of the Company, both present & future (except stocks & book debts). The asset cover thereof exceeds 100% of the principal amount of the said NCDs.

- 4 The revenue from operations for periods upto June 30, 2017 are reported inclusive of excise duty, in accordance with requirements of Ind AS. Consequent to the implementation of Goods and Service Tax (GST) regulations effective July 01, 2017, the revenue from operations for the three months ended September 30, 2017 are reported net of GST, in accordance with the requirements of Ind AS. Accordingly, the revenue from operations for the quarter and the six months ended September 30, 2017 are not comparable with the amounts reported in the immediately preceding quarter and the corresponding previous periods/ annual results.
- 5 The Company has issued and allotted 63,025,210 Equity Shares of Re. 1 each to Qualified Institutional Buyers on October 10, 2017 at an issue price of Rs. 238 per Equity Share (including a premium of Rs. 237 per Equity Share), aggregating to approximately Rs. 15,000 million. Pursuant to the allotment of Equity Shares in the Qualified Institutional Placement, the paid up equity share capital of the Company stands increased to Rs. 572.05 million.
- 6 Previous period's figures have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary to correspond with the current period's classification / disclosure.
- 7 The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on November 1, 2017. The stand-alone and consolidated results of the company have undergone limited review by the Statutory Auditors. The results of the significant subsidiaries of the Company have been subjected to limited review by their respective Statutory Auditors.
